Across 2 inspections since 2026, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.09(1)(j) Requires That for Portability for Directors, Employees and Provisional Employees, Excluding Students-in-Training, Only the Most Recently Issued Determination Letter Is Eligible for Portability and Must Be Ported Electronically. A Center May Accept a Satisfactory Fingerprint Records Check Determination Letter or a Satisfactory Comprehensive Records Check Determination Letter Issue (1), 591-1-1-.33(5)(a) Requires That Every Calendar Year After the First Year of Employment, All Supervisory and Caregiver Personnel, Except Independent Contractors, Students-in-Training and Volunteers, Shall Attend Ten (10) Clock Hours of Diverse Training Which Is Offered by an Accredited College, University or Vocational Program or Other Department-approved Source. It Was Determined Based on a Review (1), and 591-1-1-.32(1) Requires the Center to Maintain the Required Staff:child Ratios as Follows: Under 1 Year or Under 18 Months if Not Walking = 1:6 (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
