Across 3 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.36(7)(c)2. Requires That the Driver or Other Designated Person Shall Immediately Document in Writing, with a Check or Other Mark/symbol to Account for Each Child Listed on the Passenger Transportation Checklist Each Time a Child Enters and Exits the Vehicle. The Driver or Other Designated Staff Person Shall Document in Writing with a Different Mark/symbol to Account for Each Child Listed (2), Previously Cited: 91-1-1-.33(5) Requires That Every Calendar Year After the First Year of Employment, All Supervisory and Caregiver Personnel, Except Independent Contractors, Students-in-Training and Volunteers Shall Attend Ten (10) Clock Hours of Diverse Training Which Is Task-focused in On-going Health, Safety and Early Childhood or Child Development Related Topics and Which Is Offered by an Acc (2), and 591-1-1-.09(1.) (b) Requires the Center to Ensure That Every Director Has a Valid and Current Satisfactory Comprehensive Records Check Determination on File Prior to Being Present at the Center While Any Child Is Present for Care or Before an Individual Age 17 or Older Resides in the Center.
