Across 5 inspections since 2023, the issues cited most often were Associated with Investigation 591-1-1-.29(4) Requires That Within Twenty-four (24) Hours or on the Next Work Day That the Center Knows or Reasonably Should Know That There Has Been an Arrest or Change in the Comprehensive Records Check Determination of Any Director or Employee or the Fingerprint Records Check Determination for Any Provisional Employee, the Director or Designated Person -In-charge (1), Associated with Complaint 591-1-1-.03(9) Requires Center Staff to Refrain From Engaging In, or Allowing Children or Other Adults to Engage In, Activities That Could Be Detrimental to a Child's Health or Well-being, Such as but Not Limited To, Horse Play, Rough Play, Wrestling, and Picking Up a Child in a Manner That Could Cause Injury. It Was Determined Based on Investigative Findings That on Marc (1), and Associated with Complaint 591-1-1-.33(4) Requires Within the First Year of Employment, the Director and Person with Primary Responsibility for Food Preparation Shall Have Four Clock Hours of Training in Food Nutrition Planning, Preparation, Serving, Proper Dish Washing and Food Storage. It Was Determined Based on Review of Records That Staff Member #28, Date of Hire December 1, 2021, Did Not Have (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
