Across 4 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.26(4) Requires That Playgrounds Be Protected From Traffic or Other Hazards by a Four (4) Foot High Fence or Other Barrier Approved by the Department. Fencing Material Shall Not Present a Hazard to Children and Shall Be Maintained So as to Prevent Children From Leaving the Playground Area by Any Means Other Than Through an Approved Access Route. Fence Gates Shall Be Kept Closed Except When (2), Associated with Complaint 591-1-1-.32(7) Requires That Children Be Supervised at All Times Appropriate to the Individual Age, Needs and Capabilities of Each Child. Such Supervision Must Include, but Not Be Limited To, Indoor and Outdoor Activities, Mealtimes, Naptime, Transportation, Field Trips, and Transitions Between Activities.
