Across 3 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were Staff Stated Proper Knowledge of Diapering Procedures. Finding 591-1-1-.10(4) Requires That if Diapers Are Changed on a Diaper Changing Surface, the Surface Shall Be Smooth, Nonporous, and Equipped with a Guard or Rails to Prevent Falls. Between Each Diaper Change, the Diaper Changing Surface Shall Be Cleaned with a Disinfectant and Dried with a Single-use Disposable Towel. It Was Determined That (1), 591-1-1-.09(1)(c) Requires the Center to Ensure That Every Employee Has a Valid and Current Satisfactory Comprehensive Records Check Determination on File Prior to Being Present at the Center While Any Child Is Present for Care or Before an Individual Age 17 or Older Resides in the Center. The Comprehensive Records Check Determination Must Have a Records Check Clearance Date That Is No Older Than (1), and 591-1-1-.18(2) Requires the Center to Have a Designated Space for Food Preparation Separate From Rooms Used by Children and in an Area Not Used for Diaper Changing. The Area Shall Be Kept Clean and Free of Accumulation of Dust, Dirt, Food Particles and Grease Deposits. Food Preparation Surface Areas Shall Be Nonporous with No Unsealed Cracks or Seams.
