Across 4 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.25(4) Requires the Center to Maintain the Temperature in the Range of 65 to 85 Degrees Fahrenheit and to Ventilate the Center Be Ventilated Either by Mechanical or Natural Means for the Purpose of Providing Fresh Air and Controlling Unpleasant Odors. Facilities Which Do Not Have a Functioning Central Heating and Air-conditioning System Shall Make Fifty Percent (50%) of All Required Window (2), Discussed SIDS and Infant Sleeping Position. Finding 591-1-1-.30(1)(a)3 Requires That Each Crib Shall Have Only an Individual, Tight-fitting Sheet Which Is Changed Daily or More Often as Needed and Prior to a Change of Occupant. It Was Determined Based on Observation That One Crib Out Four Did Not Have a Tight-fitting Sheet. (1), and 591-1-1-.31(2)(c) Requires the Center to Maintain a Copy And/or Written Verification of the Credential or Degree Awarded to the Lead Teacher That Is Required by These Rules in the Lead Teacher's File, to Make the Document Available for Inspection and to Provide the Document to Department Staff Upon Request. It Was Determined Based on a Review of Records That in Classroom B Staff Members #4 and #7 (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
