Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.30(1)(a)3 Requires That Each Crib Shall Have Only an Individual, Tight-fitting Sheet Which Is Changed Daily or More Often as Needed and Prior to a Change of Occupant. It Was Determined Based on Observation That Three Out of Eight Cribs Had Loose Fitting Sheets Which Caused Potential Suffocation Hazards on This Date. (2), A Variety of Equipment and Toys Were Observed Throughout the Center on This Date. Finding 591-1-1-.12(4) Requires That Equipment and Furniture Is Secured if It Is of a Weight or Mass That Could Cause Injury From Tipping, Falling, or Being Pulled or Pushed Over.
