Across 2 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were Home Observed Complete Emergency Drills Finding 290-2-3-.11(2)(f) Requires That Poisons, Medicines, Cleaning Agents and Other Hazardous Materials Be in Locked Areas or Inaccessible to Children. It Was Determined Based on Observation That .The Gate to the Kitchen Was Observed to Be Open with Access to a Vacuum Cleaner and Broom with Dust Pan. (2) and 290-2-3-.19(1)(a) Requires That the Home Shall Provide Either a Safety Approved Crib or Other Equipment That Is Approved for Infant Sleep for Each Infant (Any Child Under the Age of Twelve (12) Months or Any Child Who Is Under Eighteen (18) Months of Age Who Is Not Walking), Who Cannot Climb Out of the Crib or Other Approved Equipment. Each Crib Shall Be Safety Approved in Compliance with Consumer (1). None of the 3 findings were critical.
