Across 1 inspection since 2026, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.07(5) Requires Center Staff to Not Permit Children to Wear Around Their Necks or Attach to Their Clothing Pacifiers or Other Hazardous Items. It Was Determined Based on Observation That Two Infants Present in the Main Building Classroom C Front Entrance Room Had Pacifier Clips Attached to Their Clothing. (1), 591-1-1-.09(1)(a) Requires That a Center Ensure That Every Actual and Potential Director, Employee and Provisional Employee of a Child Care Learning Center Submit Both a Records Check Application to the Department and Fingerprints to an Authorized Fingerprinting Site. It Was Determined Based on a Review of Records That the Center Submitted a Records Check Application for Staff #2 on March 23, 2026 (1), and 591-1-1-.14(2)(b) Requires That There Must Always Be One Staff Person Present in Each Classroom Where Children Are Present That Has Current and Valid Pediatric Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) and Pediatric First Aid Training. It Was Determined Based on Observation and a Review of Records That There Was Not a Staff Member Present with Current and Valid CPR and Pediatric First Aid Training in Th (1). None of the 4 findings were critical.
