It Was Determined Based on Investigative Findings That the All (1), Associated with Complaint 591-1-1-.17(2) Requires That Personnel, to the Extent Possible, Keep Children Clean, Dry and Comfortable. It Was Determined Based on an Investigation That on August 1, 2023, Center Staff Failed to Ensure That a Five-year-old Child Was Kept, Dry, Clean and Comfortable When the Child Was Observed to Be Sweating Profusely and Wearing Clothing That Was Saturated in Urine Afte (1), and Associated with Complaint 591-1-1-.29(3) Requires the Director or Designated Person-in-charge to Report or Cause to Be Reported to the Department Within Twenty-four (24) Hours or the Next Work Day: Any Death of a Child While in the Care of the Center (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
