Across 1 inspection since 2026, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.25(13) - Consultant Discussed with Director to Ensure That Wipes, Diaper Creams, Toilet Brushes, and Plungers Are Stored Inaccessible to Children. (1), 591-1-1-.26(4) Requires That Playgrounds Be Protected From Traffic or Other Hazards by a (4) Four Foot High Fence or Other Barrier Approved by This Department. Fencing Material Shall Not Present a Hazard to Children and Shall Be Maintained So as to Prevent Children From Leaving the Playground Area by Any Means Other Than Through an Approved Access Route. Fence Gates Shall Be Kept Closed Except Whe (1), and Proper Hand Washing Observed Throughout the Center on This Date. Finding 591-1-1-.17(10) Requires That if Used Potty Chairs Be Emptied in a Flush Toilet After Each Use, Cleaned with a Disinfectant and Stored in the Bathroom. If a Sink Is Used, the Sink Shall Also Be Disinfected. It Was Determined Based on Observation That the Potty Chair Had Not Been Cleaned and Disinfected After Use in Classroom (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
