Across 2 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.08(1) Requires the Center Staff to Maintain a File for Each Child While Such Child Is in Care and for One Year After That Child Is No Longer Enrolled. In Order for the File to Be Complete, the File Shall Contain the Following: Child's Name, Birth Date, Sex, Address, Living Arrangement, Name of School if Applicable (1), 591-1-1-.25(13) Requires That Potentially Hazardous Equipment, Materials and Supplies Be Stored in a Locked Area Inaccessible to Children. It Was Determined Based on Observation, the Following Items Were Found in Classroom B in a Child's Storage Basket in Reach of Children in Care: 2 Packages of Wipes, 1 Bottle of Lotion, 1 Bottle of Sunscreen and a Container of Vaseline.
