Behavior Management and Discipline Techniques (1), 290-2-3-.13(2)(a) Requires That Outdoor Play Areas Be Kept Clean and Free of Hazards Such as Exposed Sharp Corners of Concrete or Equipment, Rust and Splinters on Equipment, Broken Glass, Open Drainage Ditches, Holes and Stagnant Water. It Was Determined Based on Observation That the Provider Had Two Cooking Grills and Three Shovels Against the Playground Fence Accessible to Children That Posed A (1), and 290-2-3-.12(6) Requires All Indoor and Outdoor Furniture, Activity Materials, and Equipment Shall Be Placed So as to Permit the Children's Freedom of Movement and to Minimize Danger of Accident or Collision. It Was Determined Based on Observation That in the Licensed Area the Provider Had Chairs Stacked on Top of a Table and a Playpen on Top of a Large Brown Storage Container That Posed a Tipping (1).
