Across 2 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.36(4)(a) Requires an Annual Safety Check for Each Vehicle. The Annual Safety Check, Completed by a Trained Individual, Should Include a Check of The: Tires, Headlights, Horn, Taillights, Turn Signals, Brake Lights, Brakes, Suspension, Exhaust System, Steering, Windows, Windshields and Windshield Wipers. A Copy of the Annual Safety Check Will Be Kept in the Center or on the Vehicle and Sho (1), 591-1-1-.14(2)(b) Requires That There Must Always Be One Staff Person Present in Each Classroom Where Children Are Present That Has Current and Valid Pediatric Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) and Pediatric First Aid Training.
