Across 3 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were 290-2-3-.07(7)(a)-(j) Requires That the Provider, Employees and Provisional Employees with Direct Care Responsibilities Shall Complete Health and Safety Orientation Training Within the First 90 Days of Employment. The State-approved Training Hours Obtained Will Count Toward Required First Year Training Hours.
