Across 3 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.07(5) Requires Center Staff to Not Permit Children to Wear Around Their Necks or Attach to Their Clothing Pacifiers or Other Hazardous Items. It Was Determined Based on Observation in the Main 4-Second Right Classroom, That One 1-year-old Child Had a Pacifier Clip Attached to Their Clothing on This Date. (1), Associated with Complaint 591-1-1-.03(9) Requires Center Staff to Refrain From Engaging In, or Allowing Children or Other Adults to Engage In, Activities That Could Be Detrimental to a Child's Health or Well-being, Such as but Not Limited To, Horse Play, Rough Play, Wrestling, and Picking Up a Child in a Manner That Could Cause Injury.
