Across 1 inspection since 2026, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.08(1) Requires the Center Staff to Maintain a File for Each Child While Such Child Is in Care and for One Year After That Child Is No Longer Enrolled. In Order for the File to Be Complete, the File Shall Contain the Following: Child's Name, Birth Date, Sex, Address, Living Arrangement, Name of School if Applicable (1), 591-1-1-.26(8) Requires Climbing and Swinging Equipment to Have a Resilient Surface Beneath the Equipment and the Fall Zone From Such Equipment Must Be Adequately Maintained by the Center to Assure Continuing Resiliency. It Was Determined Based on Observation That the Mulch Under the Swings Measured One Inch Where Six Inches Is Required. (1), and 591-1-1-.10(4) Requires That if Diapers Are Changed on a Diaper Changing Surface, the Surface Shall Be Smooth, Nonporous, and Equipped with a Guard or Rails to Prevent Falls. Between Each Diaper Change, the Diaper Changing Surface Shall Be Cleaned with a Disinfectant and Dried with a Single-use Disposable Towel.
