It Was Determined Based on Observation That a Bag of Rascal and Friends Wipes That Read "Keep Out Reach of Children" Were Accessible to 2 Year- Old Children in a Child's Diaper Bag in Classroom A. (1), and Discussed Maintenance of Resilient Surface. Please Fluff and Redistribute. Due to the Inclement Weather, the Children Are Not Playing on the Playground Today. Medications Requiring Refrigeration Shall Be Placed in a Leak-proof Container in a Refrigerator That Is Not Accessibl**
