Across 3 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.36(4)(b) Requires That the Interior of a Transportation Vehicle Be Clean, in Safe Repair and Free of Hazardous Items, Objects And/or Other Non-essential Items Which Could Cause Injury. It Was Determined Based on Observation That the Bus Labeled with Tag (PHC2526) Had the Following Hazards: 1) The Second Seat on the Left Hand Side Had a Large Tear Located on the Far Right Side 2) The Third (2), Discussed Maintenance of Resilient Surface.
