Across 2 inspections since 2026, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.26(4) Requires That Playgrounds Be Protected From Traffic or Other Hazards by a (4) Four Foot High Fence or Other Barrier Approved by This Department. Fencing Material Shall Not Present a Hazard to Children and Shall Be Maintained So as to Prevent Children From Leaving the Playground Area by Any Means Other Than Through an Approved Access Route. Fence Gates Shall Be Kept Closed Except Whe (2), 591-1-1-.10(2) Requires Centers First Licensed After March 1, 1991, and Centers That Renovate Existing Plumbing Facilities, to Have a Hand Washing Sink with Running Heated Water Located Adjacent to the Diapering Area. Flush Sinks Shall Not Be Used for Hand Washing. Cleansing Procedures in Other Facilities Shall Be Approved by the Department. It Was Determined Based on Observation There Was No Heat (2), and 591-1-1-.06(4) Requires a Center First Licensed After March 1, 1991, and Centers That Remodel or Add to Existing Plumbing Facilities, to Have the Bathroom Area Fully Enclosed and Ventilated to the Outside of the Building with Either an Open Screened Window or Functioning Exhaust Fan and Duct System and Requires Centers Without Fully Enclosed Bathrooms to Ensure There Is Adequate Ventilation to Con (1).
