Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.26(9) Requires the Playground to Be Kept Clean, Free From Litter and Free of Hazards, Such as but Not Limited to Rocks, Exposed Tree Roots and Exposed Sharp Edges of Concrete. It Was Determined Based on Observation That 2 Wood Boards Were Weathered and Exposed 6 Nails on the Top Step Leading Out to the Playground and 1 Small Board Was Weathered and Broken on the Far Right of the Deck.
