Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were 290-2-3-.13(2)(a) Requires That Outdoor Play Areas Be Kept Clean and Free of Hazards Such as Exposed Sharp Corners of Concrete or Equipment, Rust and Splinters on Equipment, Broken Glass, Open Drainage Ditches, Holes and Stagnant Water. It Was Determined That Chicken Wire, a Wheelbarrow with Standing Water, and Trash Was on the Playground. Further, a Mower Parked Under the Deck Was Accessible to C (2), 290-2-3-.11(1)(n) Requires Pets in the Home Be Properly Vaccinated in Accordance with the Requirements of the Local County Boards of Health. Unconfined Pets Shall Not Be Permitted in Child Care Areas When Any Child Is Present Except for Supervised Learning Experiences. It Was Determined That One of Two Dogs Did Not Have a Record of Vaccination on File. Both Dogs Were Appropriately Caged Outside.
