Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.20(5) Requires That Medicines No Which Are No Longer to Be Dispensed Shall Be Returned to the Child's Parent(s) Immediately. It Was Determined That the Program Had Medication for Two Different Students That Were Not Returned to the Parents as Required. (2) and 591-1-1-.26(4) Requires That Playgrounds Be Protected From Traffic or Other Hazards by a (4) Four Foot High Fence or Other Barrier Approved by This Department. Fencing Material Shall Not Present a Hazard to Children and Shall Be Maintained So as to Prevent Children From Leaving the Playground Area by Any Means Other Than Through an Approved Access Route. Fence Gates Shall Be Kept Closed Except Whe (1). None of the 3 findings were critical.
