Across 1 inspection since 2026, the issues cited most often were 290-2-3-.09(3) Requires That Outdoor Activities Be Provided Daily, Weather Permitting. It Was Determined Based on Provider Statement That the Children Have Had No Outdoor Play for Several Weeks. (1), 290-2-3-.08(1) Requires the Home to Have a Current and Updated Record for Each Child in Care and for a Period of One (1) Year After Each Child Leaves. Such Records Shall Include: Identifying Information (Child's Name, Birth Date, Parent's Name, Home and Business Addresses, Telephone Numbers) (1), and 290-2-3-.11(2)(c) Requires That Documentation of Drills Required by These Rules Shall Be Maintained in the Home. The Home Shall Conduct Drills for Fire, Tornado, and Other Emergency Situations.
