Across 1 inspection since 2025, the issues cited most often were Discussed Maintenance of Resilient Surface. Please Fluff and Redistribute. Comment Playground Observed to Be Clean and in Good Repair on This Date. Finding 591-1-1-.26(8) Requires Climbing and Swinging Equipment to Have a Resilient Surface Beneath the Equipment and the Fall Zone From Such Equipment Must Be Adequately Maintained by the Center to Assure Continuing Resiliency. It Was Determined Based (1), 591-1-1-.15(2)(f) Requires That Food for Infants or Children Less Than One (1) Year of Age Be Cut Into Pieces One- Quarter Inch or Smaller and Food for Toddlers Shall Be Cut Into Pieces One-half Inch or Smaller to Prevent Choking.
