Across 3 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were 290-2-3-.07(8)(a) Requires the Home to Maintain for the Provider and Any Provisional Employee or Employee with Direct Care Responsibilities Current Evidence of Successful Completion of a Biennial Training Program in Pediatric Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) and a Triennial Training Program in Pediatric First Aid Which Have Been Offered by Certified or Licensed Health Care Professionals or Trai (2), 290-2-3-.21(1)(b) Requires Every Provider to Have a Current and Valid Satisfactory Comprehensive Records Check Determination on File Prior to Being Present at the Home While Any Child Is Present for Care or Before Residing in the Home.
