Across 3 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.19(1) Requires a Center to Provide 35 Square Feet of Usable Space per Child, Which Will Determine the Center's License Capacity. It Was Determined Based on Observation That in Building 2, Room B 11 Children Were Present Exceeding the Room Capacity of 9. (1), 591-1-1-.25(13) Requires That Potentially Hazardous Equipment, Materials and Supplies Be Stored in a Locked Area Inaccessible to Children. It Was Determined Based on Observation That in the Main Building, Room A Contained Stacked Chairs as Well as a Broom and Dustpan Accessible to Children. In Room B, a Toilet Plunger Was Accessible in the Bathroom, and a Silver and Black Purse Belonging to the St (1), and 591-1-1-.30(4). Requires That if Cots and Mats Are Stored in the Children's Activity Room or Area, They Shall Be Stored to Prevent Children's Access to Them and to Allow Maximum Use of Play Space. When Storage Is Available and Used for the Storage of Cots and Mats That Allows the Cots, Mats and Any Bedding to Be Stored Without Touching Any Other Cots, Mats or Bedding, the Bedding May Be Left on Th (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.

The First Aid Training Must Be Done by Certified or Licensed**
