Across 3 inspections since 2026, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.25(19) Prohibits the Use of Unapproved Areas for Children's Activity. It Was Determined Based on Observation That Upon Arrival to the Center a 2-year-old Child Was in the Front Lobby with Two Staff Members Who Were Both Seated. No Parents Were Leaving the Center or Pulling Out of the Center Upon Arrival. (3), Associated with Complaint 591-1-1-.07(2) Requires That Parents Be Immediately Notified and Specific Instructions Obtained Until the Child Can Be Picked Up or Returned to the Group, Immediately When Professional Medical Attention Is Required, or When the Child Experiences Symptoms of Moderate Discomfort, or When the Child Is Involved in an Incident That Puts Their Health And/or Safety at Risk and T (1), and Consultant Discussed the Caterpillar on the Front Left Playground Was Observed to Have Cracked Feet and in Need of Repair.
