Across 3 inspections since 2023, the issues cited most often were Consultant Requested to View All Criminal Record Checks for Employees Hired After Last Visit. Director Stated That There Have Been No New Hires Since Last Visit Finding 591-1-1-.09(1)(c) Requires the Center to Ensure That Every Employee Has a Valid and Current Satisfactory Comprehensive Records Check Determination on File Prior to Being Present at the Center While Any Child Is Present for Care Or (2), Please Ensure That All Rugs/carpets Are Tight and Smooth to Prevent Tripping Hazards. (1), and 591-1-1-.14(2) Requires a Staff Member Who Is Trained in CPR and First Aid to Be on the Premises and on Any Field Trip Whenever Any Child Is Present. In Addition, Staff Who Provide Direct Care to Children Must Satisfactorily Obtain Certification in First Aid and CPR by December 29, 2016 if Employed Prior to September 30, 2016 and Within 90 Days of Their Hire Date if Employed After September 30, 20 (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
