Across 3 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were Associated with Complaint 591-1-1-.07(2) Requires That Parents Be Immediately Notified and Specific Instructions Obtained Until the Child Can Be Picked Up or Returned to the Group, Immediately When Professional Medical Attention Is Required, or When the Child Experiences Symptoms of Moderate Discomfort, or When the Child Is Involved in an Incident That Puts Their Health And/or Safety at Risk and T (2), Associated with Complaint 591-1-1-.17(2) Requires That Personnel, to the Extent Possible, Keep Children Clean, Dry and Comfortable. It Was Determined Based on an Investigation That the Center Staff Failed to Keep a 4-year-old Child Clean, Dry, and Comfortable When the Child Was Picked Up From Care, Wearing Underwear and Pants That Were Observed to Be Soiled with Urine. (1), and Associated with Complaint 591-1-1-.32(2) Requires the Center Maintain Staff:child Ratios in Mixed-age Groups Based on the Age of the Youngest Group of Children That Includes More Than Twenty Percent of the Total Number of Children in the Mixed- Age Group. It Was Determined Based on Investigation That on July 23, 2025, at Approximately 4:22 P.m. There Was Mixed Age Grouping of Twos, Three, and Four (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
