Across 2 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were Associated with Investigation 591-1-1-.03(9) Requires Center Staff to Refrain From Engaging In, or Allowing Children or Other Adults to Engage In, Activities That Could Be Detrimental to a Child's Health or Well-being, Such as but Not Limited To, Horse Play, Rough Play, Wrestling, and Picking Up a Child in a Manner That Could Cause Injury. It Was Determined Based on an Investigation That on July 2 (1), Associated with Investigation 591-1-1-.29(3) Requires the Director or Designated Person-in-charge to Report or Cause to Be Reported to the Department Within Twenty-four (24) Hours or the Next Work Day: Any Death of a Child While in the Care of the Center (1), and 591-1-1-.25(13) Requires That Potentially Hazardous Equipment, Materials and Supplies Be Stored in a Locked Area Inaccessible to Children. It Was Determined Based on Observation That in Toddler II Classroom There Was Diaper Cream and Baby Powder on a Low Shelf. Further, There Was "Equate" Children's Cold Medicine in a Child's Cubbie. (1). None of the 3 findings were critical.
