Across 3 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were Associated with Investigation 591-1-1-.25(13) Requires That Potentially Hazardous Equipment, Materials and Supplies Be Stored in a Locked Area Inaccessible to Children. It Was Determined Based on an Investigation That on December 17, 2025, at Approximately 10:28 A.m., a 2-year-old Child Sustained a Burn on Their Left Hand From a Hot Glue Gun That Was Plugged Into the Wall and Placed in a Container (3), Associated with Investigation 591-1-1-.32(7) Requires That Children Be Supervised at All Times Appropriate to the Individual Age, Needs and Capabilities of Each Child. Such Supervision Must Include, but Not Be Limited To, Indoor and Outdoor Activities, Mealtimes, Naptime, Transportation, Field Trips, and Transitions Between Activities. "Supervision" Means That the Appropriate Number of Staff Membe (1), and Discussed Maintenance of Resilient Surface. Please Fluff and Redistribute. Finding 591-1-1-.26(6) Requires That Playground Equipment Provide an Opportunity for the Children to Engage in a Variety of Experiences and Shall Be Age-appropriate. For Example, Toddlers Shall Not Be Permitted to Swing in Swings Designed for School-age Children. The Outdoor Equipment Shall Be Free of Lead-based Paint, Shar (1).
