Across 4 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.33(3)(a)-(k) Requires Each Staff Member with Direct Care Responsibilities to Complete Health and Safety Orientation Training Within the First 90 Days of Employment. The State-approved Training Hours Obtained Will Count Toward Required First Year Training Hours. The Training Must Address the Following Health and Safety Topics: A)prevention and Control of Infectious Diseases (Including Immu (2), 591-1-1-.25(3) Requires the Center and Surrounding Premises to Be Kept Clean, Free of Debris and in Good Repair.
