Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.25(13) Requires That Potentially Hazardous Equipment, Materials and Supplies Be Stored in a Locked Area Inaccessible to Children. It Was Determined Based on a Observation That There Were Diaper Wipes and Plastic Bags Accessible to Children in the Restroom in Classroom B/1R. (2), 591-1-1-.30(1)(b)1 Requires That Cots and Mats Are of Sound Construction and of Sufficient Size to Accommodate Comfortably the Size and Weight of the Child (1), and Equipment and Furniture Observed to Be Properly Secured, as Applicable. Finding 591-1-1-.12(2) Requires That All Equipment and Furniture Be Free From Hazardous Conditions Such As, but Not Limited To, Sharp Rough Edges or Toxic Paint (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
