Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.25(14) Requires the Center to Be Lighted with a Minimum of Twenty-five Foot Candles of Illumination Except During Rest Periods. Areas Used for Napping Shall Be Lit Dimly. Not All Rooms Were Appropriately Illuminated When It Was Determined Based on Observation That the Boys and Girls Restroom in Classroom D Was Not Appropriately Illuminated.due to a Blown Light Bulb. (1), 591-1-1-.21(3) Requires That the Center Conduct Drills for Fire, Tornado and Other Emergency Situations.
