Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.25(13) Requires That Potentially Hazardous Equipment, Materials, and Supplies Be Stored in a Locked Area Inaccessible to Children. It Was Determined, Based on Observation, That Grocery Bags and Two Packages of Baby Wipes Were Accessible to Children on the Bottom Shelves in the Bathroom Between Room A 18 months-2- Years-old and Room B 3-4-year-olds. It Was Further Determined That a Grocery (2), 591-1-1-.26(4) Requires That Playgrounds Be Protected From Traffic or Other Hazards by a (4) Four Foot High Fence or Other Barrier Approved by This Department. Fencing Material Shall Not Present a Hazard to Children and Shall Be Maintained So as to Prevent Children From Leaving the Playground Area by Any Means Other Than Through an Approved Access Route. Fence Gates Shall Be Kept Closed Except Whe (1), and 591-1-1-.32(7) Requires That Children Be Supervised at All Times Appropriate to the Individual Age, Needs and Capabilities of Each Child. Such Supervision Must Include, but Not Be Limited To, Indoor and Outdoor Activities, Mealtimes, Naptime, Transportation, Field Trips, and Transitions Between Activities.
