Across 1 inspection since 2025, the issues cited most often were Associated with Complaint 591-1-1-.32(7) Requires That Children Be Supervised at All Times Appropriate to the Individual Age, Needs and Capabilities of Each Child. Such Supervision Must Include, but Not Be Limited To, Indoor and Outdoor Activities, Mealtimes, Naptime, Transportation, Field Trips, and Transitions Between Activities. "Supervision" Means That the Appropriate Number of Staff Members A (1), 591-1-1-.12(2) Requires That All Equipment and Furniture Be Free From Hazardous Conditions Such As, but Not Limited To, Sharp Rough Edges or Toxic Paint (1), and 591-1-1-.06(6) Requires Center Staff to Equip Bathrooms with Soap, Toilet Tissue and Single-use Towels or Cloth Towels Used Only Once Between Launderings. It Was Determined Based on Observation That All the Stalls in the Boys Bathroom Did Not Have Tissue. (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
