Across 3 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were 290-2-3-.11(1)(j) Requires Children's Hands to Be Washed with Liquid Soap and Warm Running Water: Immediately Upon Arrival for the Day and Re-entering the Child Care Area After Outside Play (1), 290-2-3-.19(2)(c) Requires That Infants Shall Only Sleep in a Safety Approved Crib or Other Equipment Approved for Infant Sleep as Described in 290-2-3-.19(1)(a) and Shall Not Sleep in Any Other Equipment, Such As, but Not Limited To, a Car Safety Seat, Bouncy Seat, Highchair, or Swing.
