Across 1 inspection since 2025, the issues cited most often were 290-2-3-.13(1) Requires That the Home Be Clean and Free From Hazards. The Consultant Discussed with the Provider to Ensure That the Home Is Properly Maintained and That Any Areas Showing Signs of Wear or Possible Damage Are Assessed and Repaired as Needed to Prevent Potential Hazards. (2), 290-2-3-.12(5) Requires All Indoor and Outdoor Furniture, Activity Materials, and Equipment Shall Be Free From Hazardous Conditions Such As, but Not Limited To, Sharp Rough Edges or Toxic Paint and Kept Clean. It Was Determined Based on Observation That the Slide Located on the Playground Equipment Was Not Secured at the Top, as Required, Creating a Potential Safety Hazard. It Was Further Determin (1), and 290-2-3-.08(1) Requires the Home to Have a Current and Updated Record for Each Child in Care and for a Period of One (1) Year After Each Child Leaves.
