Across 4 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.26(9) Requires the Playground to Be Kept Clean, Free From Litter and Free of Hazards, Such as but Not Limited to Rocks, Exposed Tree Roots and Exposed Sharp Edges of Concrete. It Was Determined Based on Observation That, Main Playground B, Main Playground C and Main Playground D Had Down Spouts From the Gutter System That Did Not Have Covers on the Bottom and Created a Hazard.
