Across 2 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.25(3) Requires the Center and Surrounding Premises to Be Kept Clean, Free of Debris and in Good Repair. Hygienic Measures Such As, but Not Limited To, Screened Windows and Proper Waste Disposal Procedures Shall Be Utilized to Minimize the Presence of Rodents, Flies, Roaches and Other Vermin at the Center. It Was Determined Based on Observation That the Following Was Found on This Date: Do (1), 591-1-1-.26(5) Requires That the Playground Have a Surface Suitable for Varied Activities. Hard Surfaces (Gravel, Concrete, Paving) Shall Not Exceed One-fourth of the Total Area.
