Such Records Shall Include: Identifying Information (Child's Name, Birth Date, Parent's Name, Home and Business Addresses, Telephone Numbers) (1), Home Observed Complete Emergency Drills Finding 290-2-3-.11(2)(f) Requires That Poisons, Medicines, Cleaning Agents and Other Hazardous Materials Be in Locked Areas or Inaccessible to Children. It Was Determined Based on Observation of the Bathroom Used by the Children That the Unlocked Bathroom Cabinet Stored Hazardous Cleaning Agents. It Was Further Determined That the Second Level Bedroom Used (1), and 290-2-3-.07(10) Requires Evidence of Orientation and Training Shall Be Documented and Maintained in the Personnel File And/or Georgia's Workforce Registry and Professional Development System of Each Staff Member Which Shall Be Available to the Department for Inspection.
