Across 4 inspections since 2023, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.25(3) Requires the Center and Surrounding Premises to Be Kept Clean, Free of Debris and in Good Repair. Hygienic Measures Such As, but Not Limited To, Screened Windows and Proper Waste Disposal Procedures Shall Be Utilized to Minimize the Presence of Rodents, Flies, Roaches and Other Vermin at the Center. It Was Determined Based on Observations That in the Following Classrooms All Carpets (2), Associated with Complaint 591-1-1-.17(2) Requires That Personnel, to the Extent Possible, Keep Children Clean, Dry and Comfortable. It Was Determined Based on Investigative Findings That on November 7, 2025, Center Staff Failed to Keep a 2-year-old Child Clean, Dry and Comfortable, After Naptime, When the Child Was Observed to Remain in a Soiled Diaper with Feces From an Undetermined Amount of Tim (1), and 591-1-1-.36(7)(c)2. Requires That the Driver or Other Designated Person Shall Immediately Document in Writing, with a Check or Other Mark/symbol to Account for Each Child Listed on the Passenger Transportation Checklist Each Time a Child Enters and Exits the Vehicle. The Driver or Other Designated Staff Person Shall Document in Writing with a Different Mark/symbol to Account for Each Child Listed (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
