Across 3 inspections since 2023, the issues cited most often were A Variety of Equipment and Toys Were Observed Throughout the Center on This Date. Finding 591-1-1-.12(4) Requires That Equipment and Furniture Is Secured if It Is of a Weight or Mass That Could Cause Injury From Tipping, Falling, or Being Pulled or Pushed Over. It Was Determined Based on Observation That a Tall Wooden Music Center in the First Right Room Was Not Secured and Could Be a Tipping Haza (1), 591-1-1-.26(9) Requires the Playground to Be Kept Clean, Free From Litter and Free of Hazards, Such as but Not Limited to Rocks, Exposed Tree Roots and Exposed Sharp Edges of Concrete. It Was Determined Based on Observation That on the Back Left Playground There Was a Net on One Side of a Wooden Bridge on the Large Structure That Was Down, a Approximately 8 Inch Patch of Concrete That Was Protrudi (1), and 591-1-1-.32(4)(b) Allows Children Who Turn Three Years Old During the Regular School Year to Remain with Two Year Olds for the Remainder of the School Year but Requires Agreement From the Older Child's Parent(s) for the Continued Placement. It Was Determined Based on Observation That Seven of the Twelve Children in Room "1st Right" Were Three Years Old in a Class with Five Two Year Olds. (1). None of the 4 findings were critical.
