### ● 5 Important

Across 1 inspection since 2026, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.03(7)(a) Requires a Center That Operates Five Hours or More per Day to Provide at Least One and One-half Hours of Outdoor Activity per Day, Weather Permitting, for Each Child Who Is Not an Infant and at Least One Hour Daily for Infants. It Was Determined Based on a Review of Records That the Center's Schedules Did Not Designate at Least an Hour and a Half of Outside Play Time. (1), 591-1-1-.08(1) - The Consultant Discussed with the Director to Ensure All Missing Information for Children Records Are Updated, (1), and 591-1-1-.26(4) Requires That Playgrounds Be Protected From Traffic or Other Hazards by a (4) Four Foot High Fence or Other Barrier Approved by This Department. Fencing Material Shall Not Present a Hazard to Children and Shall Be Maintained So as to Prevent Children From Leaving the Playground Area by Any Means Other Than Through an Approved Access Route. Fence Gates Shall Be Kept Closed Except Whe (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
