It Was Determined Based on an Investigation That on April 15, 2026, at About 4:45 P.m., a 3-year-old Child Was Observed Without Pants, and Wearing Soiled Underwear, After Being Left in the Bathroom Unattended While the Rest of the Class Transitioned Outside. (1), Associated with Complaint 591-1-1-.32(7) Requires That Children Be Supervised at All Times Appropriate to the Individual Age, Needs and Capabilities of Each Child. Such Supervision Must Include, but Not Be Limited To, Indoor and Outdoor Activities, Mealtimes, Naptime, Transportation, Field Trips, and Transitions Between Activities. "Supervision" Means That the Appropriate Number of Staff Members A (1), and 591-1-1-.12(2) Requires That All Equipment and Furniture Be Free From Hazardous Conditions Such As, but Not Limited To, Sharp Rough Edges or Toxic Paint (1).
