Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.25(13) - Consultant Discussed with Director to Ensure That Hand Lotions Are Stored Out of Reach of Children in Classroom 5R-Rm. H and That the Stapler, Hole Punch, and Paper Cutter Are Stored Out of Reach of Children in Classroom 3R-Rm.J. (2), 591-1-1-.26(8) Requires Climbing and Swinging Equipment to Have a Resilient Surface Beneath the Equipment and the Fall Zone From Such Equipment Must Be Adequately Maintained by the Center to Assure Continuing Resiliency. It Was Determined Based on Observation That the Resilient Surface Under the Swings Measured 3 Inches on Playground D-Infant-Toddler and 3 Inches Under the Swings on Playground E-P (2), and 591-1-1-.18(8) Requires That Containers of Food Be Stored Above the Floor on Clean Surfaces Protected From Splash and Other Contamination. Containers for Food Storage Other Than the Original Container or Package in Which the Food Was Obtained Shall Be Impervious and Non-absorbent, Have Tight-fitting Lids or Covers and Labeled as to Contents. It Was Determined Based on Observation That a Container (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
