Across 2 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were 591-1-1-.26(3) Requires That the Playground Be Adjacent to the Center or in an Area Which Can Be Reached by a Safe Route or Method Approved by the Department. Except in School-age Centers, the Playground Shall Have Shaded Areas. The Consultant Discussed with the Director to Ensure That the Route to the Playground Was Kept Safe and Free of Hazards, as Required. (1), Please Secure Cleaning Tools (I.e., Broom, Plunger) Out of Reach of Children. Finding 591-1-1-.25(12) Requires Heating and Cooling Equipment to Be Protected to Prevent Children From Touching It. Fans, Space Heaters, Etc. Shall Be Positioned or Installed So as to Be Inaccessible to the Children.
