Across 2 inspections since 2024, the issues cited most often were Center Observed to Maintain Appropriate Staff:child Ratios. Finding 591-1-1-.32(4) Requires That Children Under Three Years Old Be Housed in Separate Physical Areas From Older Children and Cannot Be Mixed with Older Children Except at Specified Times and Circumstances. It Was Determined Based on Observation That in Room C There Was One One Year Old Child , Twelve Two Year Old Children, and Three T (2), 591-1-1-.26(4) Requires That Playgrounds Be Protected From Traffic or Other Hazards by a (4) Four Foot High Fence or Other Barrier Approved by This Department. Fencing Material Shall Not Present a Hazard to Children and Shall Be Maintained So as to Prevent Children From Leaving the Playground Area by Any Means Other Than Through an Approved Access Route. Fence Gates Shall Be Kept Closed Except Whe (1), and Hand Washing Requirements for Diapering Were Discussed with the Director on This Date. Comment Staff Stated Proper Knowledge of Diapering Procedures. Finding 591-1-1-.10(3) Requires Center Staff to Change Diapers in the Child's Own Crib or on a Diaper Changing Surface That Is Used for No Purposes Other Than Changing Diapers and Other Clothing in Each Room Where Infants or Any Other Children Wearin (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
