Across 5 inspections since 2025, the issues cited most often were Associated with Complaint 591-1-1-.32(4) Requires That Children Under Three Years Old Be Housed in Separate Physical Areas From Older Children and Cannot Be Mixed with Older Children Except at Specified Times and Circumstances. It Was Determined Based on an Investigation That on February 25, 2026, Two 1-year-old Children, Thirteen 2-year-old Children, and Three 3-year-old Children Were Combined On (3), 591-1-1-.30(4). Requires That if Cots and Mats Are Stored in the Children's Activity Room or Area, They Shall Be Stored to Prevent Children's Access to Them and to Allow Maximum Use of Play Space. When Storage Is Available and Used for the Storage of Cots and Mats That Allows the Cots, Mats and Any Bedding to Be Stored Without Touching Any Other Cots, Mats or Bedding, the Bedding May Be Left on Th (1), and 591-1-1-.25(13) Requires That Potentially Hazardous Equipment, Materials and Supplies Be Stored in a Locked Area Inaccessible to Children. It Was Determined Based on Observation That the Following Hazards Were Accessible to the Children: ---Three Sixteen Ounce Bags of Epson Salt Was Stored in a Lower Drawer of a Filing Cabinet in Building 4 Classroom A and Accessible to the Three-year-old Children (1). None of the 5 findings were critical.
